Introduction


Welcome to Civil Air Patrol Introductory Communications User Training (ICUT). This is the initial training for all CAP personnel using CAP radios.

ICUT is offered online and includes several segments of produced video instruction. Subsequent skills evaluation by a mentor/evaluator is also required. The only prerequisites for ICUT are being an active CAP cadet or senior member, as defined by CAPR 39-2, *Civil Air Patrol Membership*, and completion of OPSEC training. All members with duties including unsupervised operation of radios on CAP frequencies must complete ICUT training.

Members authorized to operate on CAP frequencies as of August, 2012 including for both Communications Program and ES Program, as well as other administrative reasons, must re-qualify within 3 years by taking the first module of the ICUT course, Orientation to the CAP Communications System, and completing the review quiz and online test.

Completion of the ICUT modules on operation of VHF-FM radios and standard radio operating procedures is optional for those previously qualified for a CAPF 76, *Radio Station Authorization*.

The course is made up of 3 sections: OP1, T1, and OP2.

Welcome to the OP1 section of the ICUT course. Users in this section must complete two videos and a review quiz after each video, at the end of each video close the video and proceed to the quiz or exam at each section. At the end, there will be a final exam.

The review quizzes require a correct answer to complete, you will not be allowed to proceed to the next question until you answer the question correctly.

You must score 80 percent or better on the OP1 test to receive credit for this portion of the course. Once you pass the OP1 test, you can proceed to the T1 and OP2 sections of the course.

If you already have ACUT credit this is the only portion of the course you have to complete to receive ICUT credit. You may still access the material for T1 and OP2 if you would like to review it.
