SUBJECT: Dining Facility (DFAC) Dress Standards

1. The Dining Facility's goal is to promote a pleasant and healthy dining experience for all patrons using the facility. In order to provide an atmosphere where patrons can enjoy their dining experience, the following dress and appearance guidelines apply:

- a. All clothing items must be clean and in good repair.
- b. Military uniform must conform to current dress and appearance, AFI 36-2903, standards.
- c. Cell phone and headphone use is prohibited in serving line, however it is authorized in dining areas.
- d. The following items are **NOT** authorized for wear in Dining Facility:
 - 1) Swim, sleepwear or under-garments worn as outer-garments
 - 2) Any items displaying obscene, profane or lewd graphics or words
 - 3) Inappropriate clothing items that show undergarments, mid-drift (to include short shorts/dresses/skirts or extremely short cutoffs) or other inappropriate areas
 - 4) Fishnet or see-through shirts, tank tops, or any shirt/blouse that exposes the armpits
 - 5) House slippers/shower shoes, cleats or spikes
 - 6) Sweaty or soiled clothing

2. PT Uniform is authorized for wear, prior to workout, in the dining facility.

3. The Shift Supervisor has full authority to deny access to individuals not complying with the dress code. Please direct questions to the Dining Facility Manager at DSN 256-2909/4215.
