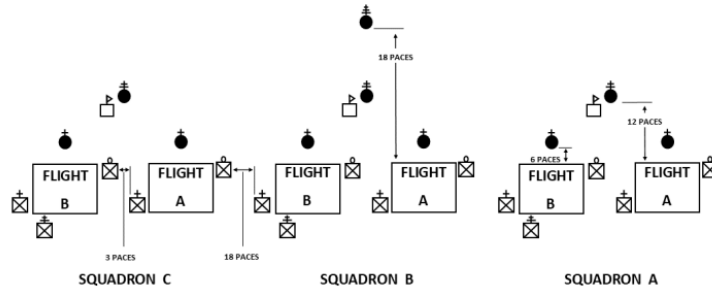

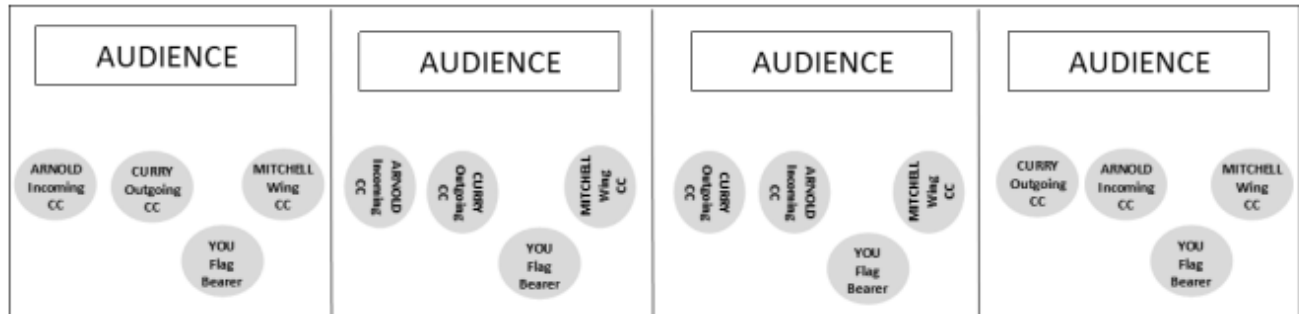

| 1b.             | Flag bearer commands "Officers, CENTER"; Arnold and Curry face right; Mitchell faces left   | 1   |     |
| 2a.             | Curry salutes Mitchell; Curry states, "Sir/Ma'am, I relinquish command"; Mitchell returns salute  | 1   |     |
| 2b.             | Curry takes flag from flag bearer and presents to Mitchell  | 1   |     |
